### Minutes of the High Powered Committee Meeting on Major Infrastructure Development Projects held on 13-01-2021 at 3.30 PM

The meeting of the High Powered Committee chaired by ACS (Finance) commenced at 3.30 PM. The list of officials is appended.

The meeting considered the proposals submitted through Higher Education Department under PLEASE (Performance Linked Encouragement for Academic Studies and Endeavours). Principal Secretary explained that this is the first set of proposals submitted by faculty of Government colleges and Universities and all of them have fulfilled the two conditions of publication of 2 papers in peer reviewed journals in the last two years and external funding except Dr. Jijo P U of Government College, Kasargod, who has not produced record of external source of research funding. However, in view of this being a proposal from Kasargod Government College, he may be provided with funding. Principal Secretary also informed that the final amount has been arrived at by deleting the amounts sought under man power as suggested by Planning Board on file and travel considering that travel is difficult under COVID 19 situation. Contingency/Travel for Rs. 1,00,000/- and internship at the rate of Rs. 10,000/per head for 5 students for one year are provided for all proposals in keeping with the Plan scheme.
