National Seminar on Plant Diversity Conservation and Bioprospecting in Western Ghats

REPORT

A two day National Seminar was organized by the Department of Botany, Government College, Kasaragod from 26-09-2018 to 27-09-2018. The venue was Seminar hall of the College. The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. A. Rajendran; Dean, faculty of Sciences and the Research Co-ordinator, Bharathiar University, Coimbatore. The function was presided over by Dr. Aravind Krishnan. K, honorable Principal of the college. Dr. V.S.Anil Kumar, HOD Botany delivered the welcome address and inaugural speech by Dr. A. Rajendran. Dr. Aravind Krishnan, principal of the college delivered the presidential address. The college union chairman, Mr. Shuwaib felicitated the function.

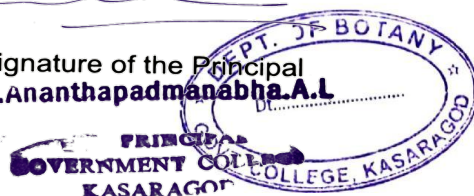
The technical sessions commenced and three technical sessions were there on the first day. The first one was by Dr. A. Rajendran on "Role of taxonomists in conservation of Biodiversity", followed by the one on "Bioprospecting of unnoticed category of plants- Bryophytes" by Dr. K. Murugan. The third technical session in the afternoon after the lunch break and was handled by Dr. Mathew Dan, scientist from JNTBGRI. He spoke on "Medicinal plant diversity, Conservation and Bioprospecting". Parallel oral and poster presentations of research scholars were carried out in the department hall as well as in the seminar hall during break periods, which were well evaluated by resource persons.

The second day began with the speech by Dr. Subbiah Karuppusamy from The Madura College, Madurai. He gave an excellent talk on Biodiversity of narrow endemic plants of Southern Western Ghats, Tamilnadu and their conservation". In the afternoon, Dr..Prabhu Kumar K.M, Senior scientist from Centre for Medicinal Plants Research, Kottakkal arya vaidyasala delivered an exemplary speech on balsams of Western Ghats followed by the talk by Dr. N. Karmegam from Govt. Arts College, Salem. Following the lunch break speech on Bryophyte taxonomy was delivered by Dr. Manju C Nair from Zamorin's Guruvayurappan College, Kozhikode. In the second day also, there were oral and poster presentations.

The program came to an end by 05. 00 pm. Best oral and poster presentations were selected and awards were given. After a brief feedback session, the programme was wound by the National anthem.

Department at a glance

The Department of Botany was established in 1978 with a graduate (B.Sc Botany) course, having student strength of ten. Currently the department nurtures thirty successful students per year. The department maintains a 'Biodiversity Park' of 3 acres with several rare, endangered and threatened plants and lianas. We have also put efforts to establish a 'star forest'. The department has been recognized by the Kerala State Biodiversity Board by awarding "Green College Award" in 2012 for Biodiversity Conservation. The department maintains a RET garden in collaboration with the Bhoomithrasana Club of the college. A few new species such as *Rotala tulunadenis*, *Eriocaulon cheemenianum*, *Isachne bharti*, *Nymphoides palyii*, *Nymphoides balakrishnanii*, *Lobelia lammersiana*, *Byssa kasargodenis*, *Miliusa patthimalayana* and *Srivillanthus malabarica* have been reported by our staff in the vicinity of Kasaragod district.

Broad spectrum of Seminar

The globally recognised Western Ghats is a pride to peninsular India by its unique biogeography. The Western Ghats constitutes a total area of 140,000 km² and is acknowledged for its tropical evergreen forest which nurtures varied species of rich biodiversity. IUCN Red data list portrays around 325 threatened species constituting the flora and fauna in this biodiversity hotspot. In addendum, new species are yet to be recognized.

Challenges and threats


The Western Ghats of India is facing severe threats to its ecosystem. The natural vegetation in this region is being drastically wane by natural calamities and anthropogenic effects. Rising human settlement has lead to over exploitation of forest products through the activities such as live stock grazing, mining, exploitation of timber wood, unhealthy ecotourism activities, unplanned dam construction and establishment of plantation in eco-sensitive areas. These kinds of detrimental activities draw attention to recent environmental disasters in Western-Ghats. In this scenario, the Department of Botany, Govt. College, Kasaragod, initiates an effort to ignite young minds on the importance of plant diversity conservation for sustainable utilization for mankind.

The core areas of the seminar are:

1. Cryptogamic diversity of Western Ghats
2. Angiosperm biodiversity and its bioprospecting
3. Threats to the Western Ghats flora and conservation
4. Ethnic medicinal plants of Western Ghats
5. Sacred groves conservational practices in Western Ghats
6. Mangrove forest conservation and its utility
7. Shola grasslands of Western Ghats
8. Any other relevant aspects of Western Ghats plant diversity

(Sponsored by the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Govt. of Kerala)**

REPORT OF THE SEMINAR

The Department of Post Graduate Studies and Research in Economics had conducted a two-day National Seminar on the broad theme “*Structural Policies and Sectoral Impacts: Theory and Empirics*” on 8th and 9th November, 2018 in two venues in parallel; one at the seminar hall and the other in the project room near to the Department. The seminar was sponsored by The Directorate of Collegiate Education. The seminar was acclaimed as a grant success in terms of the number of participants and also the number of presentations took place. Around 100 and odd participants were turned out and 26 papers were presented, followed by active deliberations and discussions on various subthemes like macroeconomic policies, growth, development, agriculture, gender, marginalization, labour, employment, inequality, environment, sustainability, health care, public finance and so on. The registration for the seminar started at 8.30 am on 8th November. The inaugural session started at 9.00 am and ended by 9.30 am. The Co-ordinator of the National Seminar, Prof. Anoopkumar M welcomed the dignitaries and the gathering and Dr. Hari Kurup K K, HoD of the Department of Economics presided over the function. The seminar was inaugurated by the Principal, Dr. Arvind Krishnan K by lightening the lamp and followed by an inaugural speech. The felicitations for the function were given by the Kannur University Syndicate Member M.C Raju, Dr. Rema M (Vice Principal), Dr. Jijo P Ulahannan (IQAC Coordinator) and Mr. Shuhaib K V (College Union Chairman). Mr. Vaishakh K V, Association Secretary of Economics, casted the vote of thanks for the inaugural session. Keynote Presentation of the seminar was delivered by Dr. M Vijayabhaskar, Professor of Economics at MIDS, Chennai and the session was chaired by Dr. Hari Kurup K K. The topic of the keynote address was “*Structural Transformation: An Impossibility?*” He stressed on the key elements of structural transformation of any society. He also discussed the policy reforms of the govt. in this regard with special reference to the state of Tamil Nadu. Heated discussions and deliberations were made on this topic by the audience.

The second session was chaired by Dr. Albin T, HoD of Economics, St Xavier’s College, Palayamkottai and three presentations were made in this session. First presentation was made by Dr. Siddik R, Assistant Professor of Economics, University of Kerala on the “*Neoliberal Economic Policy in India aka Structural Adjustment Programmes.*” He explained how markets were moving against the poor people and how the principles of efficiency in distribution were being violated. He also analyzed the contributions of the different sectors of economy towards the growth of the country. The second presentation was made by Mr. Nithin M, Asst. Professor, Govt. Arts College Kodanchery on “*Macroeconomic shocks and NPA in Indian SCBs: A Structural Macroeconomic model.*” The objectives of the study were to analyze whether the NPAs are adversely affected by the macroeconomic shocks and the external factors using macroeconomic model. He concluded that macroeconomic shocks have impact on NPAs in varying degrees and recent surge in NPAs in India are found to be due to the macroeconomic shocks. The third

presentation was made by Ms. Murshida Sulthana on ***"Intractable Petrol Prices in India: A Critical Appraisal."*** The study showed how the petrol prices are going in an upward trend after the deregulation of its prices. She concluded that the cyclicity of the petrol prices has been seem to be lost in the period after the deregulation of the prices. Discussions and deliberations were made after the presentations where the audience shared their queries and suggestions.

The third session was on the realm of women, work and wellbeing and was chaired by Prof. Retheesh P K. First presentation of this session was made by Dr. Devi Parvathy, Asst. Professor, Central university of Kerala on ***"Women and Water Equity in India"***. She explained how women are even kept away from the concept of wellbeing and equity. She also discussed that women have access to constrained social mobility. Ms. Nimisha was the second presenter who discussed on ***"Globalization and Women Labour Rights in India."*** She explained the conditions of women in their working scenario after the reform period. Objectives of the study was to learn the extent of discrimination faced by the women in their workplaces. The discussions were held after the presentations and the audience actively took part in the discussions. The fourth session was abandoned due to the inconvenience of the resources persons to come over on the date. The fifth session was chaired by Prof. Subhash P P, Assistant Professor, Govt. College Kasaragod. First presentation was made by Dr. Sumalata B S, Asst Prof, Central University of Tamil Nadu on the topic ***"Agricultural Price Support in India: Policy changes and challenges."*** She explained that price policy is directed to bring growth and equity in the country. She concluded by exploring how some MSP are even lower than the cost of production and some crops are not covered under the MSP or other mechanisms. Second presentation was made by Ms. Balkis P V on ***"Dimensions of Labour force in Lakshadeep."*** The study gave special attention to gender and rural-urban gap.

The sixth session under the theme of inequality and labour market was chaired by Dr. K K Hari Kurup, the HOD of Economics, Govt. College Kasaragod. There were two presentations in this session. The first presentation was made by Mr. Satheesha B (PhD Scholar, IIT Delhi) on the topic ***"How Unequal is Inequality in India? An Interstate Analysis."*** He examined the consumption inequality in different states of India and the causes behind this trend. He found that Kerala was better in the Average Consumption Expenditure. After the three presentations, the forum was opened for discussions where students took part actively along with other research scholars. The second presentation was made by Prof. Teeson C J on the topic ***"An Analysis of Informal Sector Labour in India with special Reference to Construction Sector in Kerala."*** The objective of the study was to analyze the factors leading to the growth of informal sector in Kerala. The paper also discussed the Govt. initiatives in providing security to the informal labour in Kerala. The seventh session was on health care management. The session was chaired by Prof. Manoj Chathoth, Assistant Professor Govt. College Kasaragod. The first presentation was made by Prof. Sindhu Joseph, Asst. Professor GPM College Manjeshwaram on the topic ***"Does Accreditation symbolizes Total Quality Management in Public Health Care Delivery."*** The presentation discussed that the quality of the public healthcare management should be upgraded and the paper concluded with some suggestions in this regard. The second presentation was made by Ms. Resmi R, Research Scholar, University of Kerala on ***"Sustainable Healthcare in Kerala: Issues and Challenges"***. She underlined various issues that were prevailing in the health care system along with the concept of Health Sustainability of Development. She evaluated the performances of healthcare from PHC to E-Health system. After the presentations, there were heated discussions and deliberations on health care system and the issues faced by it.

Session eight was on the broad theme of changing dimensions of macro policies and was chaired by Dr. Nirmal Roy, Research Associate Planning Board, Kasaragod. The highlight of the session was the two presentation. One on demonetization and the other on remittances. First presentation was made by Mr. Jijin P, Asst. Professor, Government College Kasaragod on the topic ***"Can Financial Development Drive Remittances? Evidences from India."*** He explained about the remittances as the second most important and largest source of foreign inflow to the country. He concluded his presentation stating that the financial remittances had close association with the financial development and economic openness of the country. The second presentation was made by Dr. Albin T on ***"Demonetization in India: Some Lessons to Learn."*** He critically analyzed the impacts of globalization on Indian Economy. He evaluated whether the objectives of the demonetization policy had been fully filled. The presentation concluded with short, medium and long term effects of demonetization.

The ninth session was focused on issues in marginalization and fiscal federalism. The session was chaired by Prof. Rejith R L, Assistant Professor of Economics, Govt. Arts College Thripunithara. The first presentation was made by Mr. Akhil K O on ***Economic Wellbeing and Social Position of Denotified Tribes.*** He gave special reference to the Domban community of Palakkad District. He reflected the issues faced by those communities. The second presentation was made by Prof. Midhun V P on the topic ***"Moving Towards a Co-operative Fiscal Federalism"***. He explained about the power sharing between Centre and the States and also the implications of GST over the Centre-State Relations. There was a heated discussion and debate over the topic. The third presentation was made by Mrs. Vidya P V on ***"Inequality on Asset Ownership and Its Impact on Social Development of Social Groups in Kerala."*** The audience had a heated discussion on issues of marginalization. The tenth session was on the broad theme of agriculture and migration and chaired by Dr. N. Karunakaran, Asst. Professor, EKNM Govt. College Elerithattu. The presentation was made by Ms. Kanchana K on ***"Rubber Based Industries in Kerala: An Outlook."*** She dealt with how industrialization affected the rubber industries in India. She concluded that Kerala had monopoly on rubber production. At the end of the session, chair opened the forum for discussions where the audience shared their queries.

The eleventh session was on the broad theme of industry and infrastructure and chaired by Prof. Imbichikoya K, Associate Professor, Govt. College Karinthalam. The presentation was made by Dr. J Dennis Rajakumar, Director EPW Research Foundation on ***"Some Intriguing Aspects of Corporate responses to Public Policy Changes."*** The paper showed how the corporate sector responded to the public policy changes over the last two and half decades. The presentation concluded on the note that the corporate share in income has gone up, the tax incidence has gone up whereas the tax avoidance has gone down. The session twelve was on the theme of public finance and policy and chaired by Dr. Hari Kurup K K, HoD of Economics, Govt College Kasaragod. There were two presentations made in the session. One was on the public finance theme and the other on educational status of tribes. The first presentation was done by Prof. Santhosh T Varghese, Asst. Professor, Maharajas College Ernakulam on ***"Fiscal Deficit and Real Interest Rates: The Post Keynesian Approach."*** He explained that the budgetary and monetary deficits do not reflect the structural imbalances in the fiscal operations whereas the fiscal deficit does explain it. He concluded the presentation with the arguments of Weintraub and Kaldor. The second presentation was made by Ms. Ajitha R on ***"Educational Sstatus of Tribes in Kerala: Policies and Programmes."*** She explained about the tribal illiteracy. She concluded how focusing on better education would help achieve better human development.

Final Report: National Seminar on “Hydrogeology, Hydro-informatics and Water Resource Management” held on 4th and 5th January 2019 at the Department of Post-Graduate Studies and Research in Geology, Government College Kasaragod, sponsored by the Department of Collegiate Education, Government of Kerala.

Two Day National Seminar on Hydrogeology, Hydro-informatics and Water Resource Management was inaugurated by Dr.Balasubramanian A, Professor, Department of PG Studies and Research in Geology, University of Mysore on 4th January 2019. There were Eight technical presentation including one Keynote address in the National Seminar. 48 Faculty members, 9 Research Scholars and 102 Students participated in the Seminar.

The inaugural session was presided over by the Vice-principal Dr.Remam M. Sri.Abdul Khader, Vice-president PTA, Dr.Jijo P Ulahannan, Co-ordinator IQAC and Mr.Shuib K.V., Chairman, College Union 2018-19 felicitated at the occasion. Dr.A.L.Ananthapadmanabha, HOD and Convener of the seminar welcomed the gathering Dr.A.N.Manoharan, Co-ordinator rendered the Vote of Thanks.

First session was a keynote address by Prof. Balasubramanian A., on a topic of “Modern Trends in Hydrogeology”. He explained the importance, scope and present trends in Hydrogeological studies. Importance of coastal hydrogeology in present scenario, role of hydroinformatics in coastal aquifer management and water resources management also explained by him. He appreciated the organizing committee for selecting such a topic for two day National Seminar. Prof.Balasubramanian described the Technological, Scientific and Social applications of hydrogeological studies. Historical growth of hydrogeology, Surface hydrogeology, groundwater hydrogeology, important contributions to the branch of hydrogeology, surveys and monitoring of groundwater resources, data collection and analysis, research and development, equipments, manoporous filters, procedure and product development, resources evaluation and management, water related disasters etc. were included in his keynote address.

The Session two was handled by Dr.Balasubramanian A. on topic of "Scope and opportunities of Hydrogeology". In this session he explained scope and various opportunities for those who have studied Hydrogeology. He elaborated the opportunities in technological side, scientific research in hydrogeology, water resource monitoring and commercial opportunities in hydrogeology. Groundwater exploration, well design, well development and well management are important areas where post-graduates in geology can develop their consultancy services. He stressed the need for full involvement in theory and practical study of the subject.

The third session was efficiently handled by Dr.Sajinkumar K.S., Assistant Professor, Department of Geology, University of Kerala, Thiruvananthapuram. He spoke about a topic entitled as "Visualizing Recent Floods through Satellite". Kerala, a state in southwestern India, recorded 24% excess rainfall than normal levels from June 1 to September 30 2018, leading to widespread floods and landslides events and resulting in 445 deaths. Data on the extent of flooding need to be captured before the water recedes or else the spatial data on floods will be perished. Cloud-penetrating, active radar sensors operating in the microwave region, is the best and plausible way for flood inundation research, regardless of cloud coverage. In this study, satellite-based data were used to map the flood inundation in the highly affected Kuttanad area in Central Kerala, India. Specifically, flood delineation was enabled with RADARSAT-2 and Sentinel-1A radar data of August 18, August 21, August 27, September 2, September 14 and September 26, 2018 and was compared with an average pre-flood, water-cover map based on Modified Normalized Difference Water Index (MNDWI) that was developed using a 29 January 2018 Sentinel-1A dataset. A 178.8% increase in water cover was observed during the August 2018 deluge. Low lying areas in the coastal plains of Kuttanad has marked a rise of up to 10 m of water on 18 August 2018 and has reduced to 5 m on 21 August 2018. These estimates are conservative as the peak flood spanned both 17 and 18 August 2018. Participants of the seminar interacted with Dr.Sajinkumar with great interest.

Smt.Rani V.R., Scientist C., Central Groundwater Board, Thiruvananthapuram, delivered a interesting and informative talk on Monitoring Groundwater Subsidence due to Groundwater withdrawal using RADAR data as fourth session of the seminar. The summary of the talk is as follows: Persistent Scatterer Interferometric Synthetic Aperture Radar (PSInSAR) technique was adopted to study the land response to groundwater withdrawal in parts of Kerala, India. Groundwater monitoring wells of the Central Ground Water Board (CGWB), spanning all the types of aquifer system and monitored from April 2016 to April 2017, was used to derive the water level fluctuation and this was correlated with the deformation values derived from Sentinel-1A radar data. 22 SAR images from Sentinel-1A satellite, spanning from 4 March 2016 to 3 June 2017, were used to understand the land response due to groundwater withdrawal. The area of influence of each well was calculated on the basis of pumping test carried out by various agencies and available literature. Correlation between water level fluctuation and deformation values were carried out mainly for bore wells. These wells found in crystalline aquifer show a very good correlation and are identified as a classical example of land response to water level fluctuation. Her talk proves that PSInSAR method can be used as a powerful tool to study the land subsidence induced by groundwater withdrawal.

There were four sessions including one young researchers paper presentation in second day of the seminar. Technical session fifth began with Dr.Radhakrishnan K., Professor, Department of

Civil Engineering, NMAM Institute of Technology, Nitte, Karnataka. He elaborated on Geospatial and Geophysical applications in Groundwater Investigation. Dr. Radhakrishnan explained the importances of groundwater investigations, identification of aquifers, various techniques involved in groundwater exploration. Historical development of groundwater exploration, first reference regarding groundwater investigation, conventional investigation methods its success rates etc. were included in his talk. He also explained modern techniques in groundwater exploration and opportunities in this field.

Session VI was handled by Sri. A. Prabhakaran Nair, Senior Hydrogeologist and District officer, retired, State Groundwater Department, Government of Kerala. He explained the present hydrogeological scenario of Kerala especially Kasaragod district. He mentioned about the coastal aquifer problems of many parts of Kerala coast. Various water conservation techniques especially rooftop rainwater harvesting, filtering system, well recharge, suitability of failed wells for invert recharge and various equipments available for water purification etc. were included in his presentation. Sri. Prabhakaran explained the commercial aspects of water conservation and harvesting.

Dr. Girish Gopinath, Scientist C, Centre for Water Resource Development and Management, Kozhikode, Kerala handled the session VII. He delivered a talk on Geospatial Application in Water Resources Management. His talk was mainly on applications of satellite technology in water resources management. Various satellites available on orbits, sensors, platforms, electromagnetic wave regions used for imaging, acquisition of data, data availability, constraints etc were explained very well.

Session VIII was young researchers paper presentation. There were four papers presented in this session. First paper was by Mrs. Athira K.R., Research Scholar, Department of Geology, Government College Kasaragod on Drinking and Irrigational quality of Groundwater in Lower Periyar River Basin, Thrissur, Kerala. Second paper was by Mrs. Vrunda M., on Shoreline change estimation of Azhikkal coastline of Kannur District, Kerala. The third paper was on Study of water quality status of mangrove vegetation in inland of Edayilakkad, North Kerala by Ms. Ashila Babu, Research Scholar, Department of Geology, Government College Kasaragod. The last paper was on Hydrochemical Evaluation of groundwater in Thalassery area, South Western Kannur for Irrigation purpose by Mrs. Shyni M.

The seminar was concluded by a valedictory session held at 4.30pm. The concluding session was commenced with a welcome address by Dr. Ananthapadmanabha A.L., Head of the Department of Geology followed by a valedictory address by Dr. Radhakrishnan K., Professor, Department of Civil Engineering, NMAM Institute of Technology, Nitte, Karnataka. He explained the future prospects of Hydrogeological studies in respect to global climatic changes. The concluding remarks were made by Dr. Manoharan A.N., Seminar Co-ordinator. Smt. Thankamani, Professor, Department of Civil Engineering, NMAM Institute of Technology, Nitte, Karnataka was also addressed audience. The vote of thanks was delivered by Mr. Hari Govind, Association Secretary, Department of Geology, Government College Kasaragod. The session came to an end at 5.30pm.

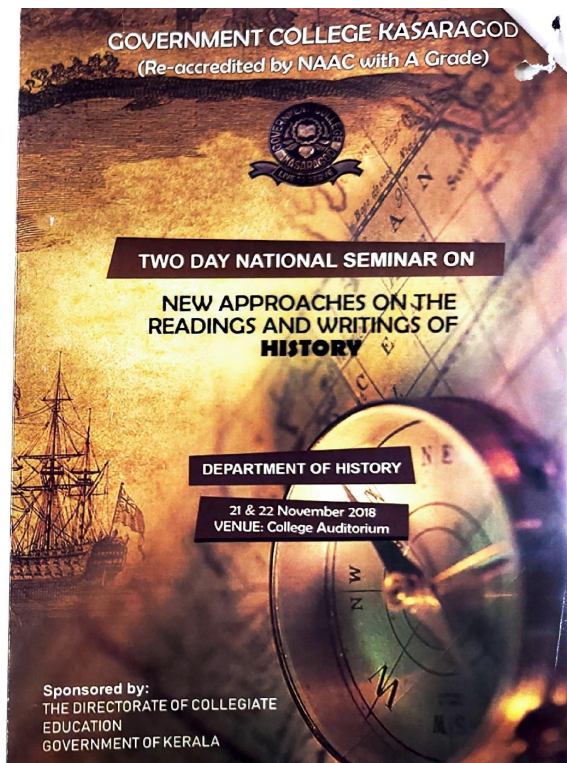
