

K. V. Tirumalesh (1940 – 30 January 2023) was an Indian poet, writer and critic in the Kannada and English languages, and a retired professor.<sup>[1]</sup> For his collections of poems Akshaya Kavya in Kannada (2010), he was awarded the Sahitya Akademi Award.<sup>[2]</sup>

#### Early life [edit]

Tirumalesh was born in 1940 in the village of Karadka in the Madras Presidency of British India (present-day Kasargod district, of the Indian State of Kerala).<sup>[3]</sup> He held a master's degree in English literature and a doctorate degree in linguistics. He taught at the English and Foreign Languages University, Hyderabad. <sup>[4]</sup>

#### Career [edit]

Tirumalesh's career as a writer began in the 1960s when he wrote the collection of poems *MukhavaaDagalu* (Masks, 1968) in the Navya style, the modernist school of writing in Kannada Illerature. His *Mahaprasthana* (1990) was said to be the result of his exploration of ways of transcending the constraints of modernism.<sup>[5]</sup> It dealt with the theme of disillusionment after victory, with the mythological heavenward journey of the Pandavas as the setting.<sup>[1]</sup>

Tirumalesh's collection of poems, *Akshaya Kavya* (2010), as described by him is an "epic fragment". [6] He elaborated: "Aksh aya Kavya imbibes this spirit in an extensive way. It is a long narrative sans story, sans didacticism, sans any aim, a sort of poetic sojourn with a lot of gaps. It is long and fragmentary at the same time: my models are Ezra Pound, William Carlos Williams and Charles Olson."[7] The work won him the Sahitya Akademi Award for Kannada in 2015.[8]










#### Brief Profile

Prof. Rajendra Pilankatta joined International Center for Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology (ICGEB), New Delhi as postdoc in 2005, after the completion of his PhD degree in Biochemistry in the area of Biochemical Toxicology from Osmania University, Hyderabad. At ICGEB, he got research training in the area of tetravalent vaccine development against dengue virus using adenovirus as a vaccine delivery vector under the mentorship of Prof. S. Swaminathan. During this period, he had an opportunity to involve in the dengue diagnostics development using NS1 protein. The vaccine research was well cited and helped to create a platform to develop tetravalent chimeric epitope against dengue virus. He joined as postdoc in Prof. G. Inesi lab at CPMCRI, San Francisco, USA and did studies on P-Type ATPase by delivering the gene by adenovius vectors (2007-2010). Following this, he expanded his research in the area of antiviral drug discovery against dengue virus, as a senior postdoctoral fellow at Harvard Medical School, Boston, USA under the guidance of Dr. Priscilla




