<u>Report</u>

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The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Cell of the college is dedicated to fostering an understanding and appreciation of IPR among the institution's stakeholders. Its core objective is to promote awareness and education on Intellectual Property Rights among the college's faculty and students.

This cell was formally established following the resolution of the college council meeting on 12th August 2021. Dr. Balakrishna B M, an Associate Professor of Kannada, was appointed as its Convener.

The IPR Cell's responsibilities extend beyond mere awareness; it plays a pivotal role in providing IPR guidance to teachers, research scholars, and students. Additionally, the cell oversees the legal and financial aspects of research paper documentation. It is observed that numerous intellectual assets remain unprotected, primarily due to a gap in understanding the significance of IPR. Addressing this, the IPR Cell imparts essential knowledge on the subject and assists in the process of filing patent applications, along with other IPR-related matters.

The operation of the IPR Cell is under the purview of the college's Research Committee.

The objectives and activities of the Cell are as follows:

- To protect the intellectual property rights generated by faculty and students of Government College Kasaragod.
- To lay down fair and transparent administrative processes for ownership control.
- To promote constant awareness about intellectual property.
- To encourage faculty members to do patent searches in-house to fine tune their research.
- To guide and advise researchers on how to obtain and sustain patents, and help them approximents (PICs).

- Patentability assessment
- Application for various intellectual property rights (IPRs), such as inventions, designs, and other creative works
- Advice and guidance on filing patents or other IPR applications
- Obtaining internal approval from the Principal and the HOD for patent applications
- Maintaining confidentiality of invention patents, trademarks, and other documents
- Drafting patent applications and filling out relevant forms
- Corresponding with the authority/agency and the inventors on IP matters
- Expediting the furnishing of information for timely actions
- Informing the IPR Cell of any further development in the related R&D work

The IPR Cell will work closely with faculty members and students to ensure that their intellectual property is protected and that they are able to obtain the full benefits of their research and development.
