Name of the Scholarships and Endowments provided by the Government and Non-Government agencies during the last five years.

Scholarships:

1.E grants

The E- grantz scholarship was established by Kerala government to enable students from underprivileged groups like SC, ST and OBC to pursue degrees, post graduate, doctoral programs, professional course with the aid of available scholarship funds. Scholarships will be given to both academics and hostellers. On an average 65 percentage of the students belong to the above category. College ensures that all these students get E - grantz.

2.Blind/PH Scholarship

Financial assistance for blind students with a family annual income of Rs 2.5 lakhs. Financial support for all PH students who are hostellers and whose family annual is below Rs 4.5 lakhs. All PH students who are day scholars and whose family annual income is below Rs 4.5 lakhs will get the reward of boarding charges.

3. State Merit Scholarship

The students pursuing studies in the first year of a UG/PG course in a Govt/Aided college/University can apply. The minimum percentage of marks to be obtained by them in the qualifying examination should



be 50% or above. The annual income of the family should be less than INR 1 lakh.

4. Suvarna Jubilee Scholarship

The scholarship is offered for students who are permanent residents of a state and belong to below poverty line families.

5. District Merit Scholarship

District Merit Scholarship is awarded by the Government of Kerala to meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections.

6. Higher Education Scholarship

Applicants should have scored 50% or above in the qualifying examination and be first year students of UG/PG. Annual income of the parent should not exceed Rs 1 lakh.

7. C H Muhammed Koya Scholarship

The students need to be from Muslim, Converted Christian or Latin communities to become eligible for C H Muhammed Koya Scholarship. The applicants need to be a girl student studying for graduation or higher courses in govt/aided institutions.

8. Post Matric Scholarship

Award financial assistance for UG/PG/PhD first year Students who should belong to minority community with annual family income upto 2 lakhs.

9. Post Matric Scholarship with Disabilities

Parents/guardians income from all sources should not exceed Rs 2, 50,000/-per annum. Not more than two disabled children of the same parents will be entitled to receive benefits of the scheme.



10. Central Sector Scholarship

Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in class Plus Two, pursuing regular degree courses with annual family income up to 4.5 lakh are eligible for scholarship.

11. Beedi Scholarship

Scheme for award of financial assistance for education to the children of Beedi workers.

12. Joseph Mundasheri Scholarship

Joseph Mundasheri Scholarship is a financial aid provided by the department of minority welfare, Government of Kerala. This scholarship provides financial support to students from economically weaker sections of society to pursue their education.

13. Snehapoorvam Scholarship

Children who belong to BPL category and the children who belong to APL category whose annual income should be below Rs 20,000 in rural areas and Rs 22,375 in urban areas are eligible.

14. Sudha Krishnan Endowment

Mrs.Sudha Krishnan Endowment has been instituted by Kannur University from an endowment corpus made by Sri V Krishnan, Bekal with the board objective to promote and assist meritorious students belonging to financially constrained groups.

15. PG Indira Gandhi scholarship for single girl child



It offers a scholarship sum to a single girl child for postgraduate study. The scholarship will support our nation's girl children in achieving their goal of receiving a top education.

16. PG scholarship for University Rank holder

University rank holders (1 st and 2 nd) at UG level admitted to PG course can apply for this scholarship. The scholarship is being offered by UGC.

17. Hindi Scholarship

Students of Kerala who have taken Hindi as one of its undergraduate-postgraduate subjects, B.Ed/M.Ed/MPhil/Ph.D, will be rewarded with a financial amount.

18. JRF Fellowship for PhD students

To provide opportunities to NET-JRF qualified candidates to undertake advanced studies and research leading to M.Phil/PhD Degrees in Humanities and Social Sciences including Languages and Sciences.

19. Aspire Scholarship

Aspire scholarship is an opportunity for the students of Kerala who belong to the financially weaker section of the State in order to offer them financial help so they can complete their PG, M.Phil and Ph.D. Degree.



Department Endowments:

1. Prof. Madhava Panicker Endowment Award

The Endowment gives financial support of Rs 2000/- for PG top scorer and Rs 1000/- for UG top scorer in the Department of Geology.

2. Prof. K Indira Endowment Award

The Endowment gives financial support of Rs 8000/- for UG top scorer in the Department of Economics.

3. Prof. K V Chandrashekhara Endowment Award

The Endowment amount Rs 7000/- is distributed for three students in the Department of Economics. Rs 3000/- to 1 st MA topper and Rs 2000/- to one student each of 1st and 2nd BA by Merit cum Means.

4. Devamma Teacher Datti Nidhi

The Endowment gives financial support up to Rs 2000/- to UG - PG top scorer in the Department of Kannada.

5. Department Alumni scholarship

The Endowment amount Rs- 10,000 is distributed to four students in the Department of Economics. Rs 4000/- for 2nd MA topper and Rs 2000/- to one student each of 2nd BA and 3rd BA by Merit cum Means. Rs 2000/- is given to a SC/ST student studying either in UG/PG.

6. Prof.Chapady Vasudeva Endowment



The Endowment gives financial support of Rs 2000/- every year for the top scorer in Common English Paper. The Endowment is given by the Department of English.

The purpose of this policy and procedure document is to give data regarding scholarships given to students by the Government. The document also provides the selection measures and award of the scholarship and endowments to students by the intent of the institution.

GOVT.COLLEGE KASARAGOD ENDOWMENTS

The Endowment funds instituted in certain departments are financial assets donated by individuals, Alumni or other entities to help or support the students. The selection criteria are decided by the donor in cooperation with the Principal and the Head of the Department.



GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

These are scholarships offered by the Central Government, State Governments and different government agencies like University Grants Commission (UGC).

AIM:

To support students' education based on their outstanding academic performance, among other influencing achievements. The institution ensures all the eligible students get government scholarships. To ensure the same a scholarship committee is constituted under a Scholarship Nodal officer in the college.

CONSTITUTION OF COMMITTEE

1. Every year a scholarship committee is constituted by the principal with a teacher acting as its convenor.
2. One faculty member each from 14 departments is a member of the committee.
3. A member from the office administrative staff is also included in the committee.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COMMITTEE

1. Promotes or disseminates information about various Scholarships and Financial grants.
2. Assists the students in the application of scholarships.
3. Monitors scholars' academic performance.
4. Screens the progress and gives follow up.



5. Coordinates concerns pertaining to scholarship with benefactors.

6. Facilitates the renewal of scholarship grants.
