SNEHAVEED

"HOME FOR THE HOMELESS" PROJECT

'Snehaveed' is one of the biggest projects the National Service Scheme, Government College, Kasaragod has ever done. The NSS unit had taken initiation of constructing two houses for students of Govt College Kasaragod who are economically backward and recorded brilliant academic achievements by scoring first and second rank in university examination. The first house was constructed at Maimoona Nagar for Kum.Mariyam Safeeda.P studying First Year M.A. Arabic. The second house is constructed at Padi for Kum.Savitha studying First Year M.A.Kannada.The NSS volunteers are collecting the fund for the construction of houses and also being the part of physical works in the process.

DREAM COME TRUE MOMENT FOR NSS

NSS unit of our college have come forward to build a snehaveed at Maimoona Nagar, Peral of Kumbala Panchayat to our student Kum.Mariyam Safeeda.P of 1st Year M.A. Arabic under the banner of "Home for the Homeless" Project. Prior to the dream project, we set up an organizing committee to control and coordinate the project, which was inaugurated by Sri.P.B.Abdul Razak (Hon.MLA of Manjeshwar (late)).

It is estimated an amount of Rs.8,00,000 (Rupees Eight Lakhs) to be raised to build up snehaveed. To raise such a huge amount, we organized the 'Snehaveed fundraising mission' which was inaugurated by Sri.N.A. Nellikkunnu, Hon.MLA of Kasaragod on January 1, 2019. We received funds from college students, teaching and non-teaching staffs, natives of Peral Kamena and from many other generous people. The foundation stone of snehaveed we had by Sri.N.A.Nehkunnu. NSS volunteers of our college actively participated in the Date Dr.Ananthapadmanabha.A.L



construction process including filling of the foundation of the building, painting works and other extension activities.

After one year of effort the key handovering function of our snehaveed was conducted on October 27, 2019. Kannur University Pro. Vice Chancellor Dr.P.T.Raveendran inaugurated the function and Kannur University NSS Coordinator Dr.Priya Varghese handed over the key to Kum.Mariyam Safeeda.P.



BLOOD STEM CELL DETECTION CAMP



JALAJAGRATHA YAJNAM PROGRAMMES






'CHANGATHI' CLASS- KERALA LITERACY MISSION

ANTI DRUG PROGRAMME


